



GUIDELINES FOR THE PUPPY REGISTER

The FLCV has available two types of puppy registration to eligible members: Current Litter Registration and Expectant Litter Registration.

The Puppy Referral Officer shall accept from the Secretary any current or expectant litter for referral to prospective buyers if the following conditions are fulfilled:

1. Both the parents have been assessed under the AVA/ANKC Canine Hip and Elbow Dysplasia Scheme (CHEDS);
2. Photocopies of the Hip Dysplasia results of both parents are enclosed with the Litter Registration;
3. Both Parents have been submitted to a qualified veterinary ophthalmologist for a general eye examination within 24 months prior to the mating;
4. Photocopies of the Eye Exam results are enclosed with the Litter Registration;
5. The prcd/PRA genotype certificates and/or Clear by Parentage certificates of both parents are to be included with the Litter Registration or where a Clear by Parentage certificate is not available, the copies of the certificates of the earlier generation;
6. The Member who owns the Dam of the litter to be registered has been a financial member of FLCV for at least the previous six months. The exception to this will be that any member who joins before February 2011 will not have a waiting period;
7. All puppies advertised on the Puppy Register are to be ANKC (State Body) registered (either Limited or Main register) and must be sold with their registration papers;
8. The prescribed fee is enclosed - currently \$10.00;
9. The Puppy Registration is on the correct form, and all details are correct, and the form is dated and signed by the FLCV Member who owns the Dam.

Failure to provide this information will result in the listing for expectant litter being removed.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Current Litter and Expectant Litter advertisements will be placed on the FLCV website
- Payment of Fee for a Current or Expectant Litter will entitle the bitch owner to advertisement of the litter for 3 months on the FLCV website and one full page advertisement in the next FLCV Newsletter. This Newsletter Advert can be either for the specific litter, or a more general advertisement for that breeder or one of their dogs
- Members advertising on the puppy register are required to comply with the FLCV Code of Ethics. Failure to do so could result in cancellation of the advertisement.
- The Puppy Referral Officer will continue to refer each registered litter for a period of 3 months, or as notified. A litter can be registered for a further three months upon payment of an additional \$10.00
- All persons enquiring about puppies will be given the FLCV website address and directed to the listings of any puppies listed with the club
- If a member shall become unfinancial, or withdraw from the FLCV, every litter which he/she has listed shall immediately be withdrawn from referral
- It shall be the obligation of every member to notify the Puppy Referral Officer when all puppies from the litter which has been listed have been sold, or when either male or female puppies are no longer available

- All copies of Hip Dysplasia results, eye exam results and prcd/PRA genotype certificates which are submitted shall remain with the FLCV health officer. These results will be strictly confidential to only the Secretary, Puppy Officer and Health Officer
- Any arrangements to purchase a puppy through an advertised FLCV litter are solely between the Breeder and the Purchaser and the FLCV is in no way responsible for implied promises or contractual arrangements
- Application forms for Puppy Registration will be available from the FLCV Website.
